NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
TO PROPERTY OWNERS AND OCCUPANTS WITHIN A 500 FOOT RADIUS

PROJECT LOCATION: **19260 W. Nordhoff Street** (see attached map).

PROPOSED PROJECT: The addition of a 1,020 square-foot, automated car wash to an existing gas station and convenience store. The request also includes the continued sale of alcoholic beverages (beer and wine) for off-site consumption, and continued operation of the business on a 24-hour, 7 days a week basis.

REQUESTED ACTION:

1. Pursuant to Section 21082.1 of the California Public Resources Code, a **Mitigated Negative Declaration** (ENV-2016-611-MND) for the above referenced project; and
2. Pursuant to Section 12.32 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC), a **Zone Change from (Q)C2-1L to C2-1L**, removing all (Q) condition restrictions; and
3. Pursuant to Section 12.24 W.1 of the LAMC, a Conditional Use Permit for the sale and dispensing of beer and wine only for off-site consumption in conjunction with the operation of a service station and convenience store;

4. Pursuant to Section 12.24 W.27, a Conditional Use Permit authorizing the operation of the service station, convenience store and proposed automated car wash 24 hours a day, seven (7) days a week, as not permitted by Section 12.22 A.28 of the LAMC.

The purpose of the hearing is to obtain testimony from affected and/or interested persons regarding this project. The environmental document will be among the matters considered at the hearing. The decision maker will consider all the testimony presented at the hearing, written communication received prior to or at the hearing, and the merits of the project as it relates to existing environmental and land use regulations. After the hearing, the Hearing Officer will prepare a report, including a recommendation, which will be considered by the North Valley Area Planning Commission at a later date.

EXHAUSTION OF ADMINISTRATIVE REMEDIES: If you challenge a City action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence on these matters delivered to the Department before the action on this matter will become a part of the administrative record. Note: This may not be the last hearing on this matter.

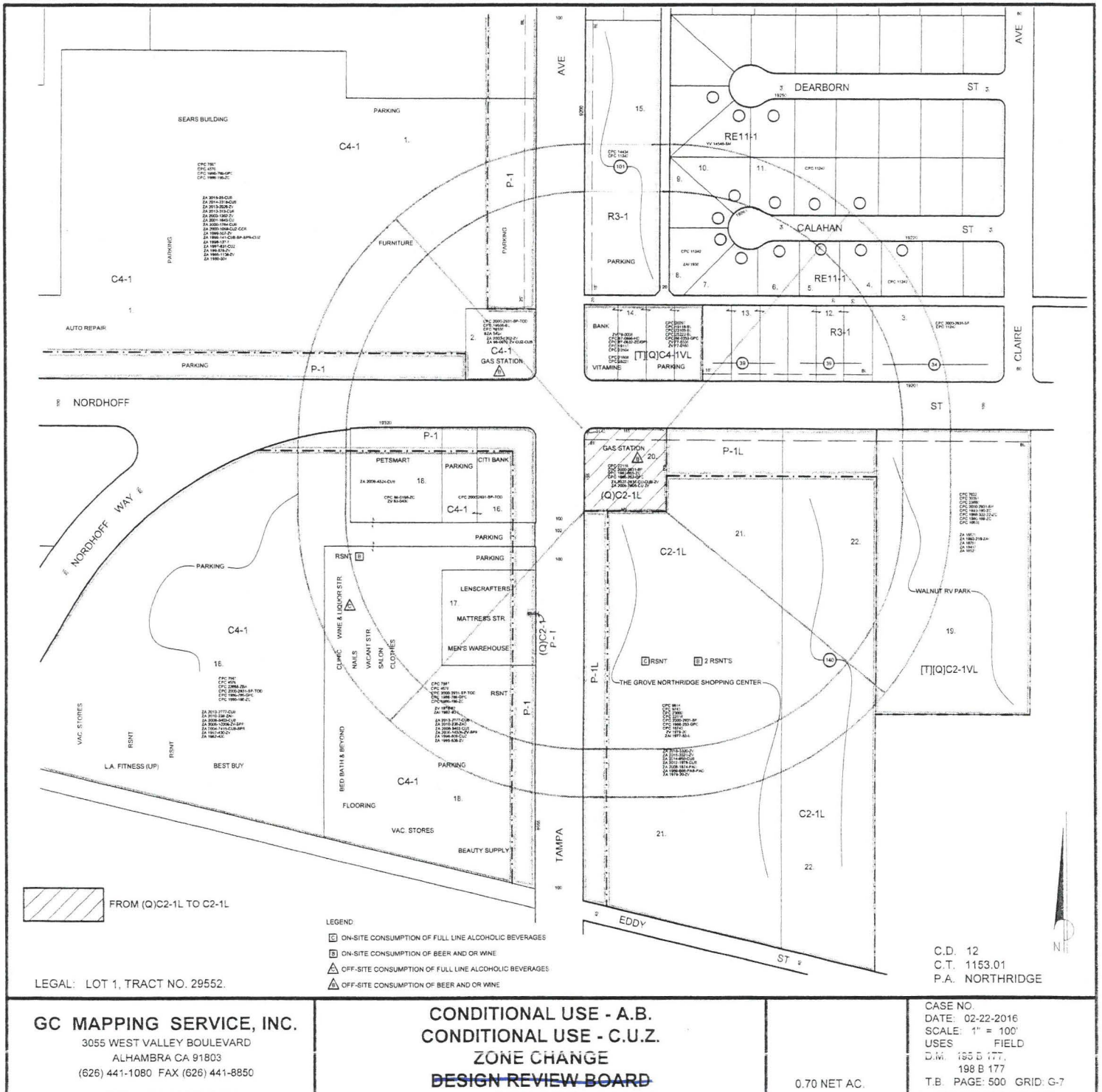

Please call the Hearing Officer indicated at the top of this notice several days in advance to assure that the file will be available. The files are not available for review on the day of the hearing.
