#### PROPOSED PROJECT:

The project is a Conditional Use to allow the sale of beer and wine for off-site consumption in conjunction with an existing 880 square foot market with requested hours of operation from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. daily.

### **REQUESTED ACTION(S):** The Zoning Administrator shall consider:

- 1. Pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") Guidelines, an Exemption from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Article 19, Section 15301 (Class 1) and Section 15305 (Class 5), and that there is no substantial evidence demonstrating that an exception to a categorical exemption pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Section 15300.2. applies.
- 2. Pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code ("LAMC") Section 12.24-W,1, a Conditional Use Permit to authorize the sale of beer and wine in conjunction with an existing market in the MU(EC) Zone.

**TESTIMONY AND CORRESPONDENCE -** Your attendance is optional; oral testimony can only be given at the public hearing and may be limited due to time constraints. Written testimony or evidentiary documentation may be submitted prior to, or at the hearing. Any materials submitted to the Department become City property and will not be returned. This includes any correspondence or exhibits used as part of your testimony.

**REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMISSION OF MATERIALS -** Written materials may be submitted prior to or during the hearing via email or by U.S. mail to the staff identified on the front of this notice. The case number must be written on all communications, plans and exhibits.

**EXHAUSTION OF ADMINISTRATIVE REMEDIES AND JUDICIAL REVIEW -** If you challenge these agenda items in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing agenized here, or in written correspondence on these matters delivered to this agency at or prior to the public hearing. If you seek judicial review of any decision of the City pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.5, the petition for writ of mandate pursuant to that section must be filed no later than the 90th day following the date on which the City's decision became final pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.6. There may be other time limits which also affect your ability to seek judicial review.

**ACCOMMODATIONS** - As a covered entity under Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act, the City of Los Angeles does not discriminate on the basis of disability.
