Planning staff answered questions of the Commission.

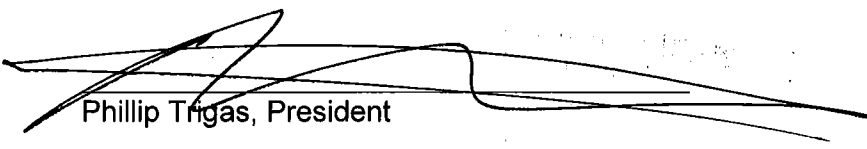
Mr. Keller gave additional information on the proposed plan.

The Commission made comments on the issues of transportation, traffic, and security. Also to add more public service.

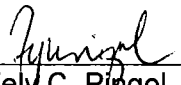
4. **PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD**
