POLICY FOR DESIGNATED PUBLIC HEARING ITEM: 4

All requests to address the Commission on public hearing items must be submitted prior to the Commission's consideration of the item.

To ensure that the Commission has ample opportunity to review written materials, members of the public who wish to submit written materials on agendized items should submit them to the Commission Office, 200 North Spring Street, Room 532, Los Angeles, 90012, at least 10 days prior to the meeting at which the item is to be heard in order to meet the mailing deadline.

The Commission may RECONSIDER and alter its action taken on items listed herein at any time during this meeting or during the next regular meeting, in accordance with Commission Policies and Procedures and provided that the Commission retains jurisdiction over the case.

AGENDAS are posted for public review in the Main Street lobby of City Hall East, 200 N. Main Street, Los Angeles, California, and are accessible through the Internet World Wide Web at <http://www.cityofla.org/pln/index.htm>

If you challenge these agenda items in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing agendized here, or in written correspondence on these matters delivered to this agency at or prior to the public hearing.

The time in which a party may seek judicial review of this determination is governed by California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.6. Under that provision, a petitioner may seek judicial review of any decision of the City pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.5, only if the petition for writ of mandate pursuant to that section is filed no later than the 90th day following the date on which the City's decision became final.

PLAN APPROVAL ANNUAL REVIEW, pursuant to Condition No. B4 of Case No. APCC-2002-1745-SPE, an Approval of Plans to provide a "One year Review" for the purpose of evaluating compliance with the 2002 Specific Plan Exception authorization granted by the Central Area Planning Commission and the effects on surrounding properties in permitting the use of a telecommunications services center with a reduction in the parking requirement from 1.1 spaces per 1,000 square feet of floor area to 1 space per 500 square feet for the first 10,000 square feet and 1 space per 5,000 square feet thereafter. The minimum required parking for the project was reduced from 498 parking spaces to 276 spaces. The One Year Review is also for the purpose of obtaining a status report on required parking area landscaping.
