Parsons v. Luhr, 270 P. 443, 444 (Cal. 1928) (holding that falling branches and leaves constituted a nuisance because they littered gutters and caused the aggrieved party to fear for their safety and granting an injunction to abate such nuisance); accord Bonde, 245 P.2d at 618–19, 621.
