RE: Request for Yellow Curb Placement on El Centro

Dear Mr. Yang,

My office received a request for a limited commercial loading zone to support the delivery needs to bring a Grocery Outlet store to Central Hollywood, an area of our district that can benefit from increased access to healthy and affordable grocery options. The yellow curb is being requested by Grocery Outlet at 6130 Sunset Boulevard, to facilitate deliveries to the grocery store. To balance the commercial loading zone needs with the day to day parking, I support a commercial loading zone that will be applicable within specified hours, and serve as a traditional parking meter stall during other hours. Below is information regarding the location of the requested commercial loading zone, hours of applicability, and neighbors engaged in this process by the requesting business.

Location

- 3 parking meters on the Eastern side of El Centro Ave, located approximately between 126' and 206' South of Sunset Blvd.
- These 3 parking meters are directly north of a curb cut 210' south of Sunset Blvd on El Centro Ave, providing access to storage via the rear of 6130 Sunset Boulevard.

Posted Restrictions Requested

- Yellow curb with posted signage stating: "Commercial Loading Only, 8am-11am, Daily"
