Project Address: Bicycle lanes are proposed in urbanized areas throughout the City of Los Angeles. The proposed bicycle lanes would provide connectivity with existing bicycle lanes thus facilitating bicycle access throughout the City. The Figueroa Streetscape project is located on a three-mile stretch of South Figueroa through Downtown and South Los Angeles from 7th Street to Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard and adjacent streets around the Staples Center.

Project Description: The proposed projects consist of the following: (1) First Year of the First Five-Year 2010 Bicycle Plan Implementation Strategy; and (2) Figueroa Corridor Streetscape Project a project centered around separated bike lane and facilitating pedestrian activity on a three-mile stretch of South Figueroa and adjacent streets around the Staples Center. The proposed project would include the implementation of approximately 39.5 miles of projects, consisting of new bicycle lanes that would be striped along existing City of Los Angeles streets within existing rights-of-way. The Figueroa Corridor Streetscape Project includes a combination of one way separated bike lanes (in the direction of adjacent traffic) within the existing roadbed and between the curb and on-street parking, and standard bike lanes with painted buffers.
