23 PRESIDENT SAMANTHA MILLMAN: Sorry to interrupt
24 you. Since we only have one person for public
25 comment, let's go ahead and give each commenter two

1 minutes.

2 MARCOS: Will do. Caller Dan, you're unmuted.

3 DANIEL WRIGHT: Hello, can you hear me?

4 PRESIDENT SAMANTHA MILLMAN: Yes, we can. Please
5 go ahead.

6 DANIEL WRIGHT: Thank you. Daniel Wright of the
7 Silverstein Law Firm. Commissioners, because you
8 removed from your agenda the Hollywood Center Project
9 items as to the entitlements, we have some general
10 comments on those entitlements, which may come before
11 you in the future.

12 You may recall that in 2013, our firm was
13 involved in warning the City that Millennium and its
14 attorneys were concealing the presence of a strand of
15 the Hollywood surface rupture fault, which could shred
16 the foundation of the proposed luxury towers.

17 When Eric Garcetti and Mitch O'Farrell ignored
18 our warnings and approved Millennium's luxury towers
19 on a rupture fault, it earned this city international
20 ridicule.

21 It is encouraging to see that the item has been
22 removed from your agenda and that Councilmember
23 O'Farrell has finally called for what appears to be
24 some kind of seismic investigation, although his
25 letter is indistinct.

1 We call for that the seismic needs to be overseen
2 by an independent geology team as requested by
3 Councilmember Roux (phonetic). Moreover, it must be a
4 fully open, transparent process done with protocols
5 known and approved by independent experts in advance,
6 including to trench deep enough and far enough south
7 as demanded by the California Geologic Survey in their
8 July 16th, 2020, letter, and it should be on both
9 sites, east and west.

10 Further, the U.S. Geologic Survey should also be
11 invited onto both sites to conduct additional guided
12 wave studies. And all of this must occur now before
13 any further processing of the project and before any
14 certification of the EIR. In fact, the current
15 certification of the EIR by the advisory agency
16 appears to be premature, given these --

17 PRESIDENT SAMANTHA MILLMAN: Time. Thank you so
18 much for your comments this morning.

19 DANIEL WRIGHT: Thank you.

20 PRESIDENT SAMANTHA MILLMAN: Okay. I believe
21 that was the last comment that we have. So I will go
22 ahead and close general public comments.


