Dear Councilmember O'Farrell,

I hope this finds you well.

I'm writing with concern about the Hollywood Center Project that seems to be steamrolling forward as everyone's attention is focused on the Covid-19 crisis that our city is now grappling with. As a resident of Ivar Hill, my neighbors and I will be directly affected by this project, which is massively over scale for this small area of Hollywood. We are already inundated by traffic on and off the freeway at Vine and Cahuenga which border the proposed project and by the many months of gridlock caused by the Hollywood Bowl season.

Street parking as already very difficult in the area and would be impossible if the staff and patrons of businesses included in the development began driving around looking for a spot on our tiny street, which is just across Yucca Street from the northwest corner of the proposed site.

In short, this project, if built, would make our neighborhood unlivable. I know Hollywood will evolve but I believe we can do it in a way that respects the surrounding neighbors and the scale of the historic Hollywood we know and love, paying respect to iconic landmarks like the Capitol Records building rather than dwarfing them.
