Would be nice if they could nexus these improvements so that they can be considered consistently for all projects rather than adhoc (which is what Luci is trying to avoid).



To offer some ideas on potential freeway improvements, here are the improvements that Farmers Field proposed for the freeway system:

- one-time contribution of \$2.5 million to Caltrans for design & installation of 5 changeable message signs on freeway mainline
- up to \$2 million to install fixed directional signage on freeway system
- one-time contribution of \$1.6 million to Caltrans to implement ramp metering upgrades
- \$2.4 million to Caltrans to fund a portion of the improvement to add an auxiliary lane on the 101 freeway
- work with Caltrans on the design and implementation of traffic management measures that are coordinated and integrated with traffic management plans led by LADOT, Metro & LAPD for events
