Good Morning Luci,

We're still working on our response to the Hollywood Center VMT analysis but the plan is to simply incorporate the previous LOS assessment with the new VMT assessment and thus the LOS mitigation measures will serve to address the new non-CEQA section of the Transportation Assessment Guidelines (TAG). Included in these requirements are measures such as Transit enhancements (sidewalk improvements / ped amenities), one-time contribution to the Bicycle Trust Fund and Traffic Signal Upgrades. The project is also proposing the installation of a new signalized ped crossing on Argyle next to the project, all of which will serve to support the objectives of the Vision Zero initiative. As for the response letter, I don't think it's necessary to call out in detail the improvements the Project will be providing but I have added the specific measures (i.e. signalized ped xing and bike lanes) that they are providing to the other measures you have cited.

Happy to discuss further if needed.
