Hi Mindy:

Per the 2109 CEQA Thresholds Guide, *Aesthetics*, (except as provided in PRC Section 21099), regarding question (c) ("would the project in an urbanized area conflict with applicable zoning and other regulations <u>governing</u> scenic quality"), does the City of Los Angeles require the evaluation of certain regulations and adopted plans in the Aesthetics Section? PRC Section 21099(d)(2) (A) provides that exemptions to aesthetic impacts on an infill TPA site do not affect, change, or modify the authority of a lead agency to consider aesthetic impacts pursuant to local design review ordinances or other discretionary powers provided by other laws or policies.

In regard to the <u>Hollywood Center EIR</u>, which, if any, of the following plans and regulations should the EIR evaluate in order to conform to the 2019 CEQA Thresholds Guide?

- General Plan Framework Element (Urban Form and Neighborhood Design Policies)
