I understand about the density bonus, but I completely disagree with the statement that the height of the project is in keeping with existing structures. It would be so far out of scale as to be absurd, and I fear it would lay the groundwork for even more buildings of this height, turning Hollywood into another downtown.

To say that the faults underneath Hollywood are not active is naive at best. They could erupt at any time. To me building a 45 story structure in that location reflects a deep denial on everyone's part. Or maybe it's simply "profit over people".
