As part of the Project, the existing two-story, 9,000-square-foot Attie Building located at the corner of Hollywood Boulevard and Wilcox Avenue would be retained and integrated with new development. The proposed structure would range in height from one to 15 stories with a maximum height of 160 feet. Upon completion, the Project would include approximately 278,892 square feet of floor area, inclusive of the 9,000-square-foot Attie Building, with a maximum floor area ratio (FAR) of up to 4.5:1. Approximately 420 parking spaces would be provided on two subterranean and three on- and above-grade levels.
