Presented in this letter are comments submitted on behalf of the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) relating to the proposed Hollywood and Wilcox Project (Project). LAUSD appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on the environmental planning process and requests that the City of Los Angeles (City) continue to consider LAUSD's neighboring schools in its development.

LAUSD's Selma Avenue Elementary School is located within 0.25 mile of the Project site at: 6611 Selma Avenue in the City. Based on the location of the Project and the scale of construction, it is anticipated that the Project may result in significant environmental impacts which have the potential to impact Selma Avenue Elementary School.

Specific environmental factors that are of concern to LAUSD and will be carried forward into the Environmental Impact Report include:

- Air Quality
- Public Services (Schools)
- Transportation and Traffic (and Pedestrian Safety)

As such, LAUSD requests that the City ensure that mitigation measures are designed for the Project to effectively mitigate impacts at Selma Avenue Elementary School. If warranted, these mitigation measures shall be designed in coordination with the administrator(s) at Selma Avenue Elementary School.
