- 6436 West Hollywood Blvd project (City Case No. VTT-74371 and CEQA No. ENV-2016-3177-EIR). The developer is proposing up to a 15-story mixed-use building with 260 residential units and 17,800 sf of commercial space.
- 6400 W Sunset Blvd project (City Case CPC-2016-3630-ZC-HD-VCU-MCUP-SPR and CEQA No. ENV-2016-3631-EIR). The developer is proposing a building with 232 residential units above 7,000 sf of ground-floor retail space.

We are also writing to request copies of all communications and mailed notice of any and all hearings and/or actions related to the Project.

Our request for mailed notice of all hearings includes hearings, study sessions and community meetings related to the Project, certification of the MND (or recirculated DEIR), and approval of any Project entitlements. This request is made pursuant to Public Resources Code Sections 21092.2, 21080.4, 21083.9, 21092, 21108 and 21152 and Government Code Section 65092, which require local agencies to mail such notices to any person who has filed a written request for them with the clerk of the agency's governing body. Our request includes notice to any City actions, hearings or other proceedings regarding the Project, Project approvals and any actions taken, or additional

documents released pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act.

Our request for all records related to the Project is made pursuant to the California Public Records Act. (Government Code § 6250 et seq.) This request is also made pursuant to Article I, section 3(b) of the California Constitution, which provides a constitutional right of access to information concerning the conduct of government. Article I, section 3(b) provides that any statutory right to information shall be broadly construed to provide the greatest access to government information and further requires that any statute that limits the right of access to information shall be narrowly construed.
