From a quick cursory review it looks like Wilcox is 46ft wide. Do you know if the proposed Two-Way Left-Turn Lane (2WLTL) will only span the block between Sunset Bl & DeLongpre?

I do not see any immediate red flags if it were limited to that block. Will the striping for the NB approach of Wilcox at Sunset be modified? I hope that we do not have to reduce the NB LT Pocket at Sunset & Wilcox.

Hi Pete – Responding to your two questions below: (1) Yes, the proposed 2WLTL will only span the block between Sunset Blvd & De Longpre Ave, and (2) No, the existing striping for the NB approach of Wilcox at Sunset will not be modified; The left-turn pocket will remain as-is. We created for you a conceptual drawing showing the proposed striping, which is attached.

Also, the existing on-street parking will remain on both sides of Wilcox Avenue, except for the proposed 150' passenger loading zone area fronting the Project site -which is shown in the attached figure.



Sconstruction Applitional Sunset+Wilcox


