RETAINING WALLS IN HILLSIDE AREAS Class 1 Conditional Use Permit (Chapter 1 Zoning)

Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 12.24 X.26 (Class 1 Conditional Use Permit) of Chapter 1 authorizes applications for retaining walls on properties located in Hillside Areas which exceed the maximum height or number allowed per Section 12.21 C.8(a) of Chapter 1. Procedures for a Class 1 Conditional Use Permit are governed by LAMC Section 13B.2.1. of Chapter 1A.

Public Hearing and Notice

Notification of a public hearing for the above process includes <u>Abutting Property Owners and</u> <u>Occupants</u> from the boundaries of the subject site and the Certified Neighborhood Council representing the area in which the property is located, as well as on-site posting of the notice. This is for informational purposes only and not required at the time of filing, unless otherwise requested. Refer to the Mailing Procedures Instructions (<u>CP13-2074</u>) and Posting Instructions (<u>CP-7762</u>) for applicable requirements.

Specialized Requirements

When filing for the above application, the following items are required in addition to those specified in the City Planning Application Filing Instructions (<u>CP13-7810</u>).

Plot/Site Plan

Provide a Plot/Site Plan of the subject property, which includes all contiguously owned parcels and shows the location and use of structures on <u>adjacent</u> properties and identifies the proposed locations of any new and/or existing retaining wall(s). Refer to the Plot Plan Instructions (<u>CP-7752</u>) for further requirements.

Elevations

Provide elevations of the proposed retaining wall(s) and indicate building materials. Refer to the Elevation Instructions (<u>CP-7817</u>) for further requirements.

Landscape Plan

For retaining walls measuring eight feet or greater in height, provide a Preliminary / Conceptual Landscape Plan which demonstrates that the retaining wall(s) will be fully screened from public view



with landscaping materials that will grow within a reasonable amount of time. Refer to the Landscape Plan Instructions (<u>CP-6730</u>) for further requirements.

Requested Action

- □ Retaining wall(s) exceeding the maximum allowable height
- □ More than two retaining walls
- Distance between two retaining walls is less than 3 feet.

Findings

The decision maker must decide if the facts presented in the record support the findings (i.e., criteria for approval) established in the LAMC. On a separate sheet, provide a detailed justification/explanation of how the proposed project conforms with the following:

- **1.** The project will enhance the built environment in the surrounding neighborhood or will perform a function or provide a service that is essential or beneficial to the community, city, or region.
- **2.** The project's location, size, height, operations and other significant features will be compatible with and will not adversely affect or further degrade adjacent properties, the surrounding neighborhood, or the public health, welfare, and safety.
- **3.** The project substantially conforms with the purpose, intent and provisions of the General Plan, the applicable community plan, and any applicable specific plan.
