- Promote a centralized parking structure that can serve the need for residents, workers, and visitors
- Encourage the revenue from local parking meters to be reinvested into the Fashion District community
- Consider expanding opportunities for housing throughout the entire Markets area.
- Improve and repair sidewalk infrastructure particularly near Santee Alley
