Palisades Fire Rebuild and Recovery

Update

Effective immediately, LA City Planning has updated its [hours of operation](#) at the LA One-Stop Rebuilding Center, 1828 Sawtelle Blvd., Los Angeles, 90025 to better serve Angelenos during the Palisades rebuild and recovery efforts.

Hours of Operation:

Monday through Friday: 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.

Saturday and Sunday: Closed

To facilitate a responsive and streamlined recovery effort, the City of Los Angeles opened a consolidated LA One-Stop Rebuilding Center, 1828 Sawtelle Blvd., Los Angeles, 90025, to help Angelenos rebuild the homes and businesses they lost due to the Palisades fires. As outlined in [Mayor Bass' Revised Emergency Executive Order 1](#), aligned with the state's issued guidance to ensure community members have all the tools available to rapidly rebuild, the Permitting Center serves as a centralized location for residents, businesses, and contractors to apply for any permits related to rebuilding and receive in-person assistance.

As the 1828 Sawtelle Blvd. location is limited to Palisades rebuild and recovery efforts, [please reach out to one of the other in-person and virtual Development Services Centers](#) for traditional City Planning services.
