

Developing A Transportation Impact Assessment Fee Program for Hollywood

As a part of the Hollywood Community Plan Update (HCPU2.org), the City is evaluating the potential for a Transportation Impact Assessment (TIA) fee program to help fund transportation improvements in the Plan area.

Q: What is a TIA Fee?

A: TIA Fee programs help mitigate the transportation impacts of development.

Q: Who Pays the Fee?

A: New development pays the fee. Affordable housing development and other desired uses, such as schools and libraries, would not pay the fee.

Q: What is the Fee Used For?

A: The TIA Fee would fund Hollywood's transit, pedestrian, bike, and roadway facilities that improve the quality, diversity, and safety of mobility options for residents, workers, and visitors.

Q: How is the fee developed?

A: Fees are developed through technical analyses and are influenced by community input and policy considerations as described below. *Hop on the bus to learn more!*
