The proposed citywide Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Program update would amend Section 12.26J of the Los Angeles Municipal Code. This update to the existing 1993 TDM ordinance proposes to create a ministerial process that would require new projects that exceed certain size and use thresholds to incorporate strategies to reduce drive-alone automobile trips and vehicle miles traveled (VMT). Projects subject to the new regulations would be required to submit a TDM Plan to the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) for review and approval before receiving a building permit. The proposed regulations would not apply to existing buildings, businesses, or residents.

La Actualización propuesta al Programa de Gestión de la Demanda de Transporte (o TDM por sus siglas en inglés) enmendará la sección 12.26J del Código Municipal de Los Angeles. Esta actualización a la actual ordenanza de TDM de 1993 propone crear un proceso ministerial que requiere a nuevos proyectos que excedan ciertos tamaños y límites de uso que incorpore estrategias que reduzcan viajes en vehículos con solo conductor y en general reducir la millas recorridas por vehículo (o VMT por sus siglas en inglés). Proyectos sujetos a las nuevas reglas serán requeridos de someter un Plan de TDM al Departamento de Transporte de Los Ángeles (o LADOT por sus siglas en inglés) para revisión y aprobación antes de recibir su permiso de construcción. Las reglas propuestas no se aplicarán a edificios, negocios o inquilinos existentes.

About the Virtual Presentation and Public Hearing

On August 2, 2022, the Planning Department will conduct a virtual Presentation and Public Hearing. The Presentation will begin at 4:00 pm and include a presentation and Q&A.

The Public Hearing will begin at 4:45 pm. The Public Hearing is a formal opportunity for the public to provide comments on the proposed TDM Program update. No decisions will be made during the public hearing. Participants may join the Public Hearing online or by phone at any time between 4:45 - 6:30 pm to offer testimony. In order that all viewpoints may be presented, speakers at the Public Hearing may be limited in the length of their testimony.

All interested persons are invited to participate in the virtual Open House and Public Hearing, which will include a presentation and opportunity to give oral comments.
