



The City of Los Angeles Department of City Planning has released a Requests for Qualifications (RFQ) for the purpose of preparing a pre-qualified list of on-call technology service providers to assist with varying technology-based work assignments and projects. Submission of Qualifications are due December 2, 2022 by 4:00PM.

This process is the sole method to become eligible for this work, and the Department of City Planning seeks a broad and wide range of interested parties to participate in the RFQ process.

A list of pre-qualified technology service providers will be established to support specific technology projects for one (1) or more of the following eight (8) Information Technology services categories:

- 1. Database Systems
- 2. Document Management
- 3. Geographic Information Systems (GIS)
- 4. Infrastructure/Cloud Solutions Services
- 5. Mobile Platform Development
- 6. Project Management
- 7. Software/Application Development
- 8. Website Design/Development

Proposers will be requested to provide/explain the type of work in connection with the service categories. Proposers do not need to be qualified in every service category to be considered.
