

# WHAT IS REQUIRED OF COMMUNITIES IN THE COASTAL ZONE?





 The state mandates that all coastal communities in California have a Certified Local Coastal Program



 The California Coastal Commission certifies Local Coastal Programs and administers them in partnership with coastal communities CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION





## WHAT IS A LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM?





### A Local Coastal Program is a planning tool that:

- $\checkmark$  Guides development in the coastal zone
- ✓ Protects coastal resources
- $\checkmark$  Maximizes public access to the shoreline
- ✓ Addresses sea level rise and climate change



## DOESN'T VENICE ALREADY HAVE A CERTIFIED LOCAL COASTAL PLAN?





# WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF CERTIFYING THE VENICE LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM?







The purpose of certifying the Venice Local Coastal Program is to:

- Create compliance with State legislation
- Create greater transparency & predictability in the coastal development review process.





#### How will we do this?

- Update the Land Use Plan; building upon existing policies in order to reflect the Community's vision
- Address sea level rise and climate change
- Draft an Implementation Plan that is consistent and enforces the Land Use Policies








- California Coastal Commission
