


An ordinance amending Section 12.04 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code by amending the zoning map.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 12.04 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is hereby amended by changing the zones and zone boundaries shown upon a portion of the zone map attached thereto and made a part of Article 2, Chapter 1. of the Los Angeles Municipal Code, so that such portion of the zoning map shall be as follows:

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and cause the same to be published by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles, to wit: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the City Hall of the City of Los Angeles; one copy on the bulletin board located on the ground level at the Los Angeles Street entrance to the Los Angeles Police Department in said City; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Hall of Records in the said City.
