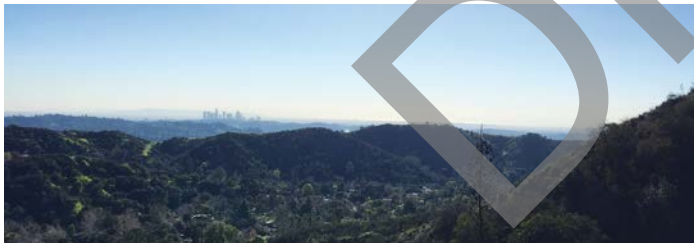

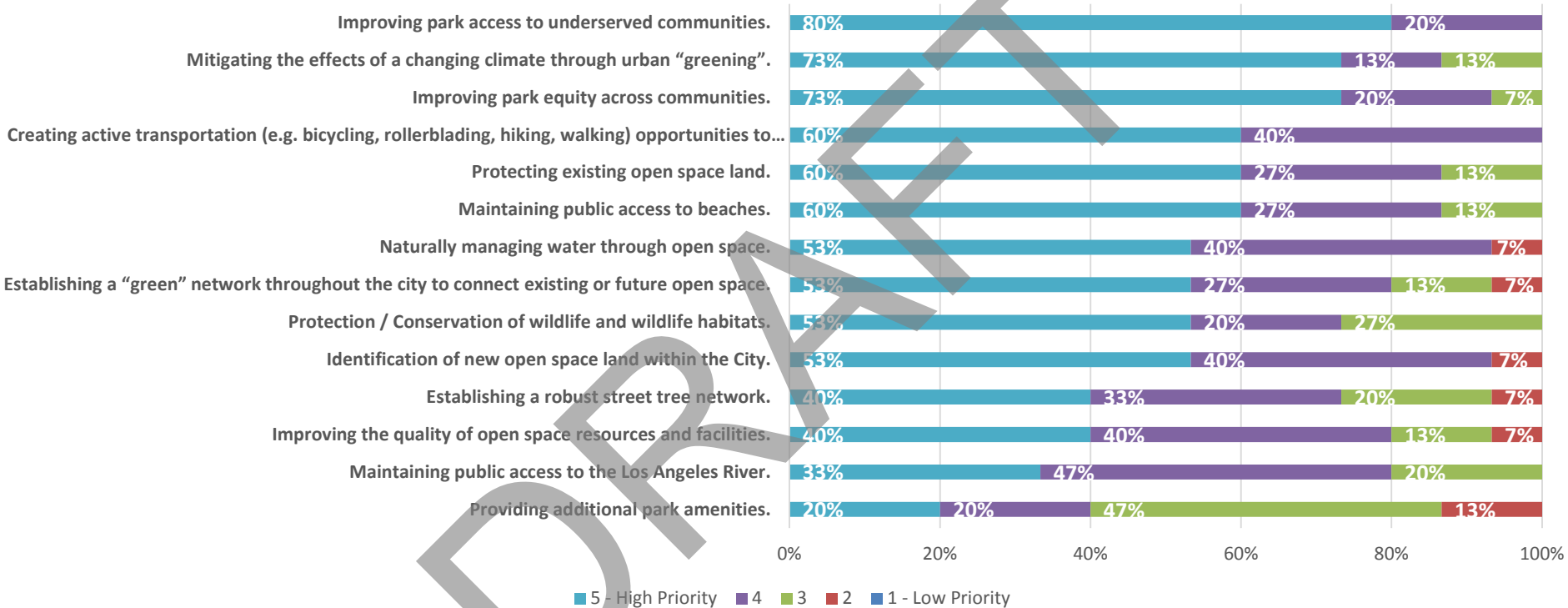


Working Group Open Space DRAFT Vision
