PANORAMA CITY COMMUNITY DESIGN OVERLAY PERMANENT [Q] CONDITIONS ORDINANCE

An ordinance establishing permanent [Q] Conditions regarding automotive uses, direct access to projects, and signage on all the zones within the adopted boundaries of the Community Design Overlay District for the Panorama City Center.

NOW THEREFORE,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: ESTABLISHMENT OF PERMANENT [Q] CONDITIONS ON ALL ZONES WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE PANORAMA CITY COMMUNITY DESIGN OVERLAY DISTRICT

- The following Q conditions shall be in addition to any existing Q, T, and D zoning conditions applying to parcels within the boundaries of the Panorama City Community Design Overlay District. All such Q, T, and D zoning conditions shall continue to apply to the zoning for these parcels.
- All auto-related uses shall be prohibited within the boundaries of the CDO. The definition of auto-related uses shall include sales, storage, rentals, installation of accessories, maintenance and repair of any motorized vehicle, including, but not limited to: automobiles, trucks, recreational vehicles, boats, jet skis, motor homes, and motorcycles.
- Any CDO projects involving new construction, significant facade modification or addition, or change-of-use involving increased trips or parking requirements shall provide a direct pedestrian pathway from the Van Nuys Boulevard public right-of-way to the entrance of the business. This direct access shall not cross a driveway entrance.
- 4) Building-mounted signage shall not total more than two square feet per linear foot of building frontage, and shall otherwise be subject to the Panorama City Community Design Guidelines.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located in the Main Street lobby to the City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the ground level at the Los Angeles Street entrance to the Los Angeles Police Department; and one copy on the bulletin

board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of
