ORDINANCE NO. 9774

(New Series)

AN ORDINANCE setting aside certain portions of the City of Los Angeles as residence districts, and prohibiting the carrying on of certain occupations within such districts.

THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL of the City of Los Angeles do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That certain portions of the City of Los Angeles are hereby set apart and declared to be residence districts of said City, the same being bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Residence District No. 1. Beginning at the intersection of the Los Angeles River with the center line of Macy Street; thence along the center line of Macy street to the center line of Mission Road; thence along the center line of Mission Road to the center line of Griffin avenue; thence along the center line of Griffin avenue to the center line of Soto street; thence along the center line of Soto street to the center line of Mission Road; thence along the center line of Mission Road to the easterly Boundary of the City of Los Angeles; thence northerly and easterly along the said Boundary to the northeast corner of said City; thence westerly and southerly along said Boundary to the Los Angeles River; thence southerly along the Los Angeles River to the center line of Pasadena avenue; thence along the center line of Pasadena avenue to the center line of Avenue 18; thence along the center line of Avenue

18 to the center line of Mozart street; thence along the center line of Mozart street to the center line of Avenue 19; thence along the center line of Avenue 19 to the center line of Main street; thence along the center line of Main street to the center line of Lamar street; thence along the center line of Lamar street to the center line of Alhambra avenue; thence along the center line of Alhambra Avenue to the Los Angeles River ; thence along the Los Angeles River to the point of beginning.

Residence District No. 2. Beginning at the intersection of First street and Robinson avenue; thence northerly along the center line of Robinson avenue to the center line of Bellevue Avenue; thence along the center line of Bellevue avenue to the center line of Micheltorena Street; thence along the center line of Micheltorena street to the center line of Reservoir street; thence along the center line of Reservoir street to the center line of Hyperion Avenue; thence along the center line of Hyperion Avenue to the center line of Effie Street; thence along the center line of Effie street to the center line of Echo Park Road; thence along the center line of Echo Park Road to the center line of Sunset Boulevard; thence along the center line of Sunset Boulevard to the center line of Centennial street; thence along the center line of Centennial street to the center line of Temple street; thence along the center line of Temple street to the center line of Hill street; thence along the center line of Hill street to the center line of First street; thence along the center line of First street to the point of beginning.

Residence District No. 3. Beginning at the intersection of the center lines of First Street and Figueroa Street; thence along the center line of First Street to the West Patent Boundary of the City; thence along said West Patent Boundary to the south line of the Dayton Heights Tract; thence along the south line of the Dayton Heights Tract to the center line of Vermont Avenue extended; thence along the center line of Vermont Avenue extended, Vermont Avenue and the prolongation of Vermont Avenue to the center line of Seventh Street; thence along the center line of Seventh Street to the center line of Figueroa Street; thence along the center line of Figueroa Street to the point of beginning.


Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to erect, establish, maintain or carry on, within any of the districts described in section 1 hereof, any public laundry or wash house.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$100 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period not exceeding 50 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in The Los Angeles Daily Times
