SUMMARY

Built in 1929 and located in the Hollywood area, this 14-story apartment building exhibits character-defining features of Chateauesque-style architecture. The square-plan apartment building has an arched centered entrance with decorative molding and lattice windows. The building is clad in a brick and concrete finish and has a hipped roof with a roof ridge, slate tile and decorative dutch-style gables. A neon roof sign spelling the word "Fontenoy" is located on the roof of the building atop the roof ridge. Significant interior spaces include an entry lobby with rope ornate plaster work and trim and marble flooring.

The proposed Fontenoy historic monument was designed in 1929 by architect Leland A Bryant. Bryant designed several luxury apartment buildings in highly decorative period-revival styles including the Trianon (1928; Historic-Cultural Monument #616) and the Romanesque Villa Apartments (1928) in West Hollywood. Bryant also designed the landmark Art Deco-style Sunset Towers (1929) in West Hollywood, now the Argyle Hotel. The subject building was designed by Bryant within this short but productive time span in the late 1920s.

The Fontenoy building appears significant for its Chateauesque-style architecture by a noted architect of ornate 1920s luxury apartments.

Later additions to the subject property include replacement of windows.

CRITERIA

The criterion is the Cultural Heritage Ordinance which defines a historical or cultural monument as any site (including significant trees or other plant life located thereon) building or structure of particular historic or cultural significance to the City of Los Angeles, such as historic structures or sites in which the broad cultural, economic, or social history of the nation, State or community is reflected or exemplified, or which are identified with historic personages or with important events in the main currents of national, State or local history or which embody the distinguishing characteristics of an architectural type specimen, inherently valuable for a study of a period style or method of construction, or a notable work of a master builder, designer or architect whose individual genius influenced his age.

FINDINGS

Based on the facts set forth in the summary and application, the Commission determines that the application is complete and that the property is significant enough to warrant further investigation as a potential Historic-Cultural Monument.

Addendum to Significance Worksheet

The Fontenoy was designed by famed California architect Leland A. Bryant. Mr. Bryant also designed the Sunset Towers (the Argyle), the Trianon, among many other existing art deco and chateauesque structures in and around Hollywood.

Leland A. Bryant specialized in designing luxury apartments. His crowning achievement however was the Sunset Tower (Argyle).

Today, the Fontenoy remains a fully functional apartment building, with no vacancies. The SWEL group has dedicated time and money in an effort to restore the building to its original splendor, while leaving the building's historic integrity in tact.

The building towers over the historic neighborhood on Whitley, two blocks North of Hollywood Boulevard. The building hosts a lighted rooftop sign, which is one of several original neon signs in the historic area.

The Hollywood Heritage archives include many examples of color post cards dated from the mid 1920's reflecting the presence of this unique building. The building has stood the test of time in the Hollywood community.
